Messages from RugbyWA

RugbyWA will be staging one final **SmartRugby** course for 2010 as a “mop up” on Monday 12th July, 6:30pm – 8:30pm at Nedlands Rugby Club. Over the past two weekends RugbyWA has attempted to deliver all Walla, Mini & Midi coaches with copies of the Laws of the modified versions of the game. This process was instigated as a result of RugbyWA fielding numerous enquiries in relation to inconsistencies of games being played week to week. As a result of these inconsistencies there is confusion for players, coaches & parents week to week on how to play the game.

The three points that are regularly raised are:

- 1. Offside at the tag in Walla Rugby.** There is no offside once a player has been tagged in Walla Rugby. Once the player carrying the ball has been tagged (tag = two hands simultaneously around the waist or lower), the referee calls pass, pass, pass at which time the ball carrier has the opportunity to pass the ball. The referee should not stop the game at this point to push the defence back 5 metres. **Benefits:** continuous play, broken defensive line, more activity for all participants & players enjoy the unique skills of these activities.
- 2. Scrums & lineouts** must be played in all modified versions of the game including Walla Rugby. Playing scrums & lineouts distinguishes rugby union from other sports & it is an element of the game that should be taught at training. **Benefits:** it introduces new & different skills to players (body shape, throwing, jumping & catching), creates space by separating teams & creates attacking opportunities as players are out of the defensive line participating in the scrum or lineout.
- 3. The No.8 in a Midi Scrum cannot pick up the ball** from the back of a scrum. The half must clear the ball (i.e. run or pass). **Benefits:** attacking opportunity for backline, improve passing & attacking skills of backs, clears the ball from traffic.

It is important for all coaches/referees to coach/referee & manage games according to the Laws so as to provide a consistent game for participants. The current Laws have been developed after detailed research so as to provide a safe, fun, active & learning experience for all participants. Any referees or coaches officiating modified games should keep the following in mind: **“Kids should be allowed to play the game in a simple & free-flowing manner letting the game flow with the safety of the players the overriding consideration. Allowing “advantage” is an effective method of maximising playing time & reducing the number of stoppages, & it is recommended coaches/referees promote this whenever possible”** (Refereeing Kids Rugby, pg 4).
