Please note the following important points:

The carnival will take place at Southern Lions Home Ground- Success Sporting Complex, Success.

- As with all draws, the fixtures are as equitable as possible. There are some matches played after each other and some where there are gaps in between matches, this is simply part of the draw. Similarly there are a couple of central clubs that are V each other for one of their games; this too has been unavoidable for this carnival.
- The length of matches is the same for all age groups: 10 minutes each way, with a few minutes in between and a few minutes to get on and off the field. *Please be mindful that we are on a very tight schedule for the day, so please ensure your team is ready to play all matches at the kick off times reflected in the draw.*
