Welcome to the Home Junior Competition 2007.

During the off-season, the Western Australian Junior Rugby Union and RugbyWA held a series of meetings with the Town of Vincent concerning junior rugby's continued usage of Britannia Oval. As part of our ongoing commitment to the Town of Vincent and Britannia Oval, we ask that you support us in the following areas:



**Parking.** Britannia Oval gets very busy on a Saturday morning, and car parking is at a premium. Please be advised that the Town of Vincent's Rangers will be patrolling the area, and will be issuing fines to those that park illegally. The fees associated with these infringements are as follows:

There is additional parking available on Bourke Street at the Southern End of Britannia, and we have secured a number of bays in the Floreat Athena car park on Egina Street. Please ensure you park in front of the line of witches' hats before the gate to Floreat Athena.

Wherever possible, participants and spectators should car pool to get to Britannia; not only will this alleviate parking and congestion problems, but will save on fuel costs. To further assist we have created a drop off zone in the Main Car Park, where participants can alight and the driver can continue on to find a car parking space or leave Britannia.



**Litter.** Over the past few seasons, litter has become a major issue for junior rugby. To help tackle the problem we will shortly be supplying additional litter bins to supplement those already at the Oval. Please remember **it is your responsibility** to ensure litter is disposed of correctly.

**Spectator Behaviour.** Please be aware that all patrons of Britannia Oval are subject to the WAJRU code of conduct, and as such are expected to conduct themselves accordingly. Breaches of the code of conduct have, in the past, resulted in spectators being banned from Britannia. The toilets at Britannia are located at the Clubrooms. The bushes, trees and shrubs around the Oval are not to be used as a substitute.
